In between, our Benefice will revisit the extraordinary events of Holy Week in innovative and time-honoured ways, beginning with a Palm Sunday procession through Marazion. Later in the week, we enjoy food and fellowship in a re-enactment of the Last Supper. Our traditional Holy Week services then lead us into our Easter morning celebrations.

For many, these celebrations will involve the consumption of an Easter egg (or two!) and perhaps a hunt for them. It's thought that the tradition of the Easter egg hunt originated in Germany and was introduced by the Protestant reformer, Martin Luther: the men would hide the eggs and the women would search for them. This was said to reflect the fact that it was women who were the

The egg is an ancient symbol of life and for Christians, it came to represent the resurrection of Jesus and the new life he offers - not only life after death.

Food will be served. Please buy your ticket in advance. And on Maundy Thursday there will be the usual Benefice service with footwashing at 7pm in Ludgvan, when the preacher and president will be the Very Revd Christine Wilson.
